Children can only attend once all information has been received and checked. Those wishing to start from January 2017 will be able to make bookings during November.

3. Complete and return your booking forms as soon as possible

We know that the children will enjoy the activities with their friends and hope that parents will find it makes the logistical challenges of school pick-ups a little easier.
