<p><u>Religious Education</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Learn School Prayers -Take part in Welcome Mass and recognise some of the ways they are made to feel welcome -To explore the importance of their own name and to know that God knows and loves each person. -Say 'Thank You' to God at Harvest time - Learn about other faiths, Rosh Hashanah 	<p><u>Communication, Language and Literacy</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Learn to listen attentively and respond to simple instructions -Use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences -Learn a variety of Jolly Phonic sounds and actions -Re-tell familiar stories -Show awareness of rhyme and alliteration
<p><u>Personal, Social and Emotional Development</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -To be able to express their own feelings -To be confident to talk to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions -To begin to accept the needs of others and can take turns and share resources. 	<p><u>Physical Development</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Learn how to use outdoor play equipment safely -Be able to run, jump, skip and hop -Use a pencil and hold it effectively to form different sorts of lines and patterns -Stop and start on request
<p><u>Maths</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Estimating, counting and ordering numbers to 20 -Recognise numbers to 10 -Write numbers to 10 -Name and describe 2D shapes -Recognise, create and describe patterns -Fine 1 more and 1 less to 10 	<p><u>Understanding the World</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Our topic this half term is 'Marvellous Me' -Find out about their school environment -Learn the five senses -Use their senses appropriately to examine objects and surroundings -Find out about past and present events in their own lives
<p><u>Computing</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Use the keyboard to type their name -Learn how to print their work -Learn how to use computer hardware i.e. mouse 	<p><u>Expressive Art and Design</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Explore colour, texture, shape and form -Use collage technique -Observational drawing of themselves and friends -Use appropriate colours
