

## **Pupil Premium at Ss Alban & Stephen Infants 2014-15**

Pupil Premium is additional funding for pupils receiving certain benefits at any time during the last six years, those looked after by the Local Authority and children of armed service personnel. Government has recognised that economic disadvantage could affect their progress.

In 2014-15, schools received £1300 per pupil. We look at the needs of individual children then allocate funds to close any gap between these children and their peers so that they can achieve their potential.

The Pupil Premium allocation for Ss Alban & Stephen Infants school in the academic year 2014-15 was £15,956. This money was used to

- Subsidise after school clubs for focus pupils
- Provide small group interventions and 1:1 support in Maths and English for focus pupils to raise attainment
- Provide family support workers and counselling for individual pupils to manage emotions and improve attitudes to learning
- Provide enrichment activities to promote language and physical development, and improve writing

### **Impact**

At the end of Year 2,

Reading - 80% of PP pupils achieved level 2 with 60% exceeded age-related expectations (L2A+)

Writing – 80% of PP pupils achieved level 2

Maths – 60% of PP pupils achieved level 2 with 40% exceeding age-related expectations (L2A+)

A review of pupil premium provision has been undertaken and findings will be incorporated into pupil premium planning for 2015-16. Priorities will be to improve outcomes, especially in writing and Maths.
