- R.E. Lent: time to work at the good like Jesus and be ready to celebrate Easter.
- English: Finding information from books. Planning and writing their own reports. Making an information book about Easter and a growing diary.  
Phonic work: a-e, i-e, o-e, u-e, e-e, oi, oy and wh.
- Maths: Knowing numbers that are more or less.  
Solving problems involving counting, adding, subtracting, doubling and halving. Solving problems and working on finding a system for finding all the possibilities. Finding fractions of shapes and numbers and describing turns - whole, half etc.
- Science: Growing Plants. Knowing what plants need to grow. Recognising different parts of a plant. To be aware of the seasonal changes - temperature, length of day and observing changes to plants and trees.
- Computing: To understand that we can organise ideas and information in different ways. To discuss how these might be helpful.
- Art/CDT: Develop observational skills in drawing. To design and decorate different cards.
- Geography: To learn about our local area. To find out about houses and homes. To find out about places where people work and jobs people do in our local area.
- P.E.: Gymnastics - Learning to make different shapes and to link some together to make a sequence.
