September/October 2016

- R.E. To feel welcome and to recognise what it is to be part of their family, the school, the church and God's family. To celebrate and learn about harvest time.
Listen to and discuss bible stories.
- English: Independent, shared and guided reading. Reading range of fiction and non-fiction texts.
Writing simple sentences, lists, instructions and narrative based on traditional tales.
Phonics work: sh,ch, th, ng, ar, ow, or.
- Maths: Formation of numbers. Counting and ordering numbers.
Numbers: one more and one less. Addition and subtraction calculations. 2D and 3D shapes. Measure using non-standard units. Money: coin recognition and adding small amounts.
- Science: Topic: Ourselves. To identify and locate parts of their body, including sense organs; recognise changes that take place as animals get older. To use their observations to point out differences between humans and other animals and between animals and non-living things.
- Computing: To develop keyboard and mouse skills. To use computing vocabulary eg input, output, algorithm. To collect data and produce graphs on computer. To use the i-pad to take photographs. To understand and learn the e-safety rules.
- Art/CDT: To begin to develop observational skills in their drawing.
- PE/Games/Dance Explore travelling in different ways, link actions together.
