Religious Education

- Learn School Prayers
- Take part in Welcome Mass and recognise some of the ways they are made to feel welcome.
- To explore the importance of their own name and to know that God knows and loves each person.
- Say 'Thank You' to God at Harvest time.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- To be able to express their own feelings
- To be confident to talk to others about own needs, wants, interests and opinions
- To begin to accept the needs of others and can take turns and share resources.

Maths

- Counting and ordering numbers to 20.
- Recognise numbers to 10.
- Name and describe 2D shapes.
- Recognise, create and describe patterns.
- Find 1 more and 1 less to 10 using a variety of resources.

Computing

- Use the keyboard to type their name
- Learn how to print their work
- Learn how to use computer hardware i.e. mouse.

Communication, Language and Literacy

- Learn to listen attentively and respond to simple instructions.
- Use language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences.
- Learn a variety of Jolly Phonic sounds and actions.
- Re-tell familiar stories.
- Show awareness of rhyme.

Physical Development

- Learn how to use outdoor play equipment safely.
- Be able to run, jump, skip and hop.
- Use a pencil and hold it effectively to form different sorts of lines and patterns.
- To experiment with different ways of moving.

Understanding the World

- Our topic this half term is 'UK Spaces and Amazing Places'.
- Find out about their school environment.
- Learn the five senses and use their senses to examine objects and surroundings.
- Talk about similarities and differences between families and friends.

Expressive Art and Design

- Explore colour, texture, shape and form.
- Use collage technique to express thoughts and ideas.
- Use appropriate colours.
