<u>Curriculum Information for Reception Parents</u>

Spring Term - 1st Half 2019



Religious Education

- Learn about Epiphany and the visit of the wise men to baby Jesus.
- Learn about the celebration of Candlemas.
- Learn about the Church and the local Church community.

Communication, Language and Literacy

Our topic this half term is 'Take one Author'. Foundation Stage have chosen to look at Julia Donaldson.

- Use imagination to recreate roles and experiences.
- Use Julia Donaldson books as stimulus for learning
- Continue to learn letter names and sounds, using Jolly Phonics
- Blend sounds to read and spell simple words
- Begin to form simple sentences.
- Learn to read tricky words and begin to write them.

Physical Development

- Focus on developing core strength.
- Use a range of large equipment.
- Develop ability to balance on different body parts.
- Handwriting continue with the I family and learn the correct formation of letters.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Learn about setting goals, how to set own individual goals and how to achieve them.
- Understand that people have different needs, views and beliefs and that others should be treated with respect.
- Learning social skills, sharing and turn taking.

Maths

- In practical activities begin to use vocabulary involved in subtracting and write corresponding number sentences.
- Solving number problems.
- Learn to write numbers accurately to 10/20.
- Look at ordering items by weight and using scales to measure the weight of different items.

Understanding the World

- Observe, find out about and identify features in the place they live and the natural world.
- Begin to know about own cultures and beliefs.
 (Learn about Epiphany and Candlemas)
- To look at how we look after our planet.

Computing

- Use painting program brush, fill and text tools.
- Use Beebot robots to follow a route on a variety of mats.
- Continue to have independent access to the computers and use the hardware to interact with programmes.

Expressive Arts and Design

- Explore colour, texture, shape, form and space in 2 and 3 dimensions.
- To use a range of materials and tools when designing and making.
- To use imagination in role-play situations.
- Using stories as a stimulus for music.
