Online safety

The school's Online Safety policy provides guidance on appropriate online behavior to ensure the safety of children in our care. Staff, Governors, volunteers, parents and pupils are required to sign a form to confirm that they will adhere with our online safety rules. A copy of these will be sent home via book bags today together with an Acceptable Use Agreement form. Please discuss the rules with your child. Both parents and children should then sign the Acceptable Use Agreement to confirm that they will follow our rules. Please return signed forms to school where they will be kept on record.
