




Curriculum Information for Reception Parents

<p><u>Religious Education:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Reconciliations: How to be a good friend and what Jesus tells us about friendship. -To look at different faiths around the world and develop an awareness of similarities and differences between different communities with a focus on Judaism, Hinduism and Sikhism. -To learn about the Creation Story 	<p><u>Communication, Language and Literacy:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Revise all phonemes learnt so far and continue to learn to read and write tricky words. -Use phonic knowledge to write for a variety of purposes and build a narrative. -Continue to use the correct sentence structure and punctuation in their writing, -Learn to write letters of the 'R' Family.
<p><u>Physical Development:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Athletics - Participate in a range of team games involving co-ordination of small and large movements such as ball skills and hopping and skipping. 	<p><u>Personal, Social and Emotional Development:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Changing Me: Looking at growth and change and celebrating the end of the school year. -Preparing for Transitions
<p><u>Mathematics:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Solve practical problems involving counting to 10 and 20, addition and subtraction. -Count in steps of 2,5 and 10 and apply them to problem solving sums. -To use estimation skills to guess an amount of objects and count to check. 	<p><u>Understanding the World:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Learn about Australia, the geography of the country, traditions and foods eaten. -To talk about people and communities and acknowledging differences. -To talk about the effects of human activity on our world with a link to the Great Barrier Reef.
<p><u>ICT:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -To develop more independence in accessing programmes for a purpose. -To develop more control of the mouse. 	<p><u>Expressive Arts and Design:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Explore Australian Art Work such as Aboriginal paintings. -Use Australian influences such as buildings, animals and musical instruments as a basis for junk modelling and creative work.
